Food, drink and bag policy

- Only a single factory-sealed water bottle is allowed inside. If the bottle has already been opened you can't bring it in. Unopened juice boxes are allowed to be brought inside for children.
- The only food permitted is unopened snacks and baby formula.
- Bags can be brought inside, provided they are smaller than 16" x 16" x 8".

Getting autographs

Because players enter the field through doors in the right field wall they don't have to walk close to the fans in the stands, which isn't a good setup for those wanting to get autographs. Furthermore, the protective screen attaches to the ends of the dugouts, effectively serving as a barrier there between fans and players or coaches. Despite these obstacles not all hope is lost. When Cleveland is playing in Goodyear, before the game begins some Indians players will sign down the right field line. Visiting players who sign do so down the left field line, near the tarp. When the Reds play at home, the inverse is true, meaning Cincy players sign down the left field line and the visitors in right. The pattern here is the right field line is a much more bountiful place to get autographs than the left field line.

There's plenty of food options, but not much that is out of the ordinary. The most original choices actually involve an old standby, the hot dog.
