

AREA INFO

The area surrounding Florida Auto Exchange Stadium is as quaint as the ballpark itself. Downtown Dunedin is just a half-mile away and features charming restaurants and storefronts on a classic small-town Main Street. Businesses that line the avenue that the ballpark is on look like well-kept houses and the streets of nearby residences are lined with trees dripping with Spanish moss. All in all, it feels like a modern day Mayberry with a coastal vibe. The water is just a block away and the city's Edgewater Park and Municipal Marina can be reached by car in a few minutes. The Pinellas Trail, a 14-mile paved path for bikers, runners and walkers, runs right through downtown.

Travelers' notes

- The closest Interstate, I-275, is about 20 miles away.
- Tampa International Airport is 15.4 miles away. Other major airports nearby are Sarasota Bradenton (45 miles) and Orlando (94 miles).
- The National Armed Services & Law Enforcement Memorial Museum is just down the street from the stadium.
- Nearby Caladesi Island State Park, reachable by ferry, was named America's # 1 beach in 2008 by noted coastal research expert Dr. Stephen Leatherman.
- There are no safety concerns here, as the ballpark is in a safe neighborhood in a safe city.
- The city limits of Clearwater are just a mile south of Florida Auto Exchange Stadium and the 5 mile distance between it and the Phillies' Bright House Field is the shortest distance between two Grapefruit League ballparks.
