LOOKING BACK AT LAST SPRING

Unfortunately for the Twins, success in spring training didn't carry over to the regular season. At 19-11, they had the best record in the Grapefruit League in 2011. Then they went 63-99 to finish with the worst record in the American League. The Twins did have a stellar season at Hammond Stadium, where they won seven straight games to close the spring and sold out all 16 of their games, averaging 8,091 per game in the process. That ranked them 3rd in the 15-team league for average home game attendance.
