

Dugout Field Box

Sections 6-13 and 17-24

Seat rows: 4 to 10 in sections 6-10 and 20-24; 1 to 8 in section 11; 1 to 10 in sections 12-13 and 17-19

As their name implies, these seats are directly behind the dugouts, which are wide enough that five sections of seating are behind each of them. In 2011, an extra half-dozen sections that were previously sold as Home Plate Box (sections 11-13 and 17-19) had their classification changed to Dugout Field Box.

Cost: \$37 or \$42

Baseline Field Box

Sections 1-5 and 25-29

Seat rows: 1 to 10 in sections 1-2, 5, 25, 28-29; 1 to 8 in sections 3-4 and 26-27

Each side of the ballpark has five sections of Baseline Field Box seats, which start just beyond the dugouts and extend down the left and right field line.

Cost: \$28 or \$33

Infield Box

Sections 106-124

Seat rows: 1 to 19 in sections 106-108, 112, 118, 121, 123-124; 1 to 22 in sections 109-111, 113-117, 119-120, 122

This massive category of seating comprises the upper two-thirds of the grandstand that stretches from dugout to dugout. They have great views of the playing field and its backdrop. Because they are all within the infield they provide a close to the action feel, but maybe more importantly they are the closest seats to the covered portion of the concourse that is the sole respite from the sun in the sun-drenched ballpark.

Cost: \$24 or \$29
