

### **Loge Box**

Sections 201-213

Seat rows: 1 to 12 in sections 201-203 and 209-213; 1 to 8 in sections 204-205; 1 to 11 in sections 206-208

Situated in a symmetrical manner around the infield, Loge Box seats are elevated above the cross aisle, thereby making them the upper level of the seating bowl. There's really little difference between them and the Field Box seats below, hence the minimal price difference between the only two types of seating sections in the grandstand.

**Cost:** \$26, \$30 or \$35

### **Bleachers**

Sections 301-304

Seat rows: 1 to 16 in all sections

Placed well down the left field line, the bleachers in Jupiter do not have seat backs but the four sections of them are all banked towards the playing field.

**Cost:** \$15, \$20 or \$25

### **Berm**

General Admission

Tucked into the right field corner not too far from the foul pole is what's best described as a small hill. The berm here is the smallest of any found at a spring training ballpark. Capacity is just 200 people and all 200 berm tickets go on sale the day of the game. They are actually very popular "seats" though, as the lawn area is directly behind the Cardinals bullpen, and fans must have a berm ticket to enter the berm, a policy that is enforced by ushers. Since berm tickets can only be bought on game day, the advanced sale prices listed below are for SRO (Standing Room Only).

**Cost:** \$8, \$12 or \$16
