PRACTICE FIELDS

Two joined half fields and a full practice field are located behind the main stadium. The full field is very fan friendly. It has three sets of bleachers, a concession stand and bathrooms. In addition to that field, the Yankees also often utilize Steinbrenner Field during the practice only portion of spring training, making them the only Grapefruit League team to use their stadium for training and games.

During February workouts, fans can roam back and forth between the Steinbrenner field and main practice field. Gates to the stadium open circa 10 a.m. and its paved parking lot, off-limits to most on game day, is free to park in for all. "Stadium pricing" is only in effect at the concession stands, some of which are open to serve the relatively small (less than 1,000 people) gatherings that enjoy the intimate access that is absent once March rolls around.
